Make the Sacred text **a solemn focus** for this Sunday. It is through the Holy Spirit who makes Sacred Scripture the Living Word of God.

The **homily** should help people understand Scripture through simple suitable language. There are many online resources to help with preparing homilies.

Every home should have a Bible which becomes part of our daily prayer life. Can your parish **provide Bibles** for people on request? Can your parish provide attractive **Bible resources** for children? Two places to buy Bibles and Scripture resources are Pleroma

Use this Sunday, or one close to this, as an opportunity to celebrate or introduce the **volunteers who proclaim the Word** at Mass. Your parish leadership/liturgy team might use this Word of God Sunday as a time to commission readers and/or provide training for this important role.

Lectio Divina is a method of prayer which goes back to the early monastic tradition. We are encouraged to listen with our hearts to the scripture reading because it is the Word of God that we are hearing. Whether one prays individually or in a group, Lectio Divina is a flexible and easy way to pray. One first listens, notes what is given and responds in a way one is directed by the Holy Spirit.

Invite people to an **ecumenical celebration** or sharing, using Scripture as the pathway to a more united Christian community.
